Test Bed Report**

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Introduction

This report summarizes the test bed activities, customers, discoveries, and other information deemed mutually relevant from January 1, 2013, through March 31, 2013 as described in subsection (i) of Section 16-108.8 of the Public Utilities Act ("Act").

ComEd Test Bed Quarterly Report

During the first quarter of 2013, ComEd did not receive any Test Bed Applications or inquiries regarding potential applications for deployment in the Smart Grid Test Bed.

In the previous quarter, ComEd had been in discussions with Global Midwest Alliance, a not-for-profit economic development organization comprised of more than 150 companies and institutions throughout the Midwest, to help them determine what specific application they would like to demonstrate in the Test Bed and the requirements for their prospective demonstration. ComEd had no further discussions with, nor received any inquiries from, Global Midwest Alliance during the first quarter of 2013.

Otherwise, ComEd met with representatives of Underwriters Laboratories (UL), the Energy Foundry and Ameren Illinois at UL headquarters in Northbrook, Illinois, to discuss potential opportunities to work together in the future. At this time, no further plans or commitments have been made in this regard.
